Evangelists (Spiritual obstetricians). They have a special ability to:

Communicate the gospel to unbelievers.

Find those who will believe in Christ.

Teach other believers how to share the gospel effectively.

Pastor/teachers (Spiritual pediatricians). They have a special ability to:

Lead, provide for, and care for believers through the teaching of the Word of God.

Teachers. (Romans 12:7) They have a special ability to:

Convey Bible knowledge to other believers to build foundational truths upon which they can grow.

Exhorters. (Romans 12:8) They have a special ability to:

Encourage and admonish believers so they will do what needs to be done.

Organizers. (“ruling” Romans 12:8) They have a special ability to:

Take the leadership in arranging good works which need to be done.

Administrators. (“government” 1 Cor. 12:28) They have a special ability to:

Guide, pilot, or lead the affairs of the local church.

Exceptional faith. (1 Cor. 12:9; 13:2) They have a special ability to:

Have faith beyond the norm which can remove obstacles to church progress.

Exceptional givers. (Romans 12:8; 1 Cor. 13:3) They have a special ability to:

Distribute their own goods or money freely without grudging or expecting personal benefits in return.

Helpers. (1 Cor. 12:28) They have a special ability to:

Do the menial tasks in the church to free people with other gifts to use theirs.

Ministers. (Romans 12:7) They have a special ability to:

Be hospitable and assist people on their way.

Mercy showers. (Romans 12:8) They have a special ability to:

Show compassion for those who are suffering.
